

OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

HOW TO USE THIS PLAN

Daily Time: ~30 min: 15 min reading · 10 min reflection · 5 min confession.

NT First: The NT reading is your main focus. The OT reading enriches it.

Confessions: Speak confessions aloud — agree with what God says about you.

Repeat if Needed: If a chapter hits deep, stay there tomorrow. Depth beats volume.

Star Chapters ■: Especially powerful passages. Meditate, don't rush.

No Condemnation: Miss a day? Just pick up where you left off. This plan is grace-based.

*"Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God
and of Jesus our Lord." — 2 Peter 1:2*

DAY 1 ■ *The Word Became Flesh*

NT READING

John 1:1–18

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 23

John 1:16 — 'From his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *God is not angry at me. He came near in Christ because He loves me.*
- *I am known, I am loved, and I am never alone.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 2 ■ *Born Again by Grace*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

John 3:1–21

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 103:1–12

John 3:17 — 'God did not send his Son to condemn the world, but to save it.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I have been born of the Spirit. I am a new creation — not a reformed old one.*
— *God so loved ME — this is personal, not just theological.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 3 ■ *Righteousness as a Gift* □

Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 3:21–31

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 53:1–6

Romans 3:24 — 'Justified freely by his grace through the redemption in Christ Jesus.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. This is not earned — it is given.*
— *I have been justified freely. My standing before God is secure.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 4 *Faith Credited as Righteousness* □

Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 4:1–16

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 32

Romans 4:5 — 'God justifies the ungodly. Their faith is credited as righteousness.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— Like Abraham, I believe God. My faith — not my performance — is my righteousness.

— I do not strive for what God has already freely given.



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 5 ■ *Peace with God*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 5:1–11

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 46

Romans 5:1 — 'We have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— I have peace with God through Jesus Christ. I stand in grace — not in my efforts.

— While I was still a sinner, Christ died for me. That settles my worth.



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 6 *Grace That Abounds*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 5:12–21

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 55:1–3

Romans 5:20 — 'Where sin increased, grace abounded all the more.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— Where sin abounded, grace abounded much more. I am not defined by Adam's failure.

— I am defined by Christ's gift — not by my past.



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 7 ■ *Dead to Sin, Alive to God*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 6:1–14

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 51:1–12

Romans 6:14 — 'Sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are under grace.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I am dead to sin and alive to God. Sin is no longer my master.*

— *I reckon myself dead to sin and alive to God — this is a fact, not a feeling.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 8 *Free from Sin's Slavery*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 6:15–23

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 3:5–8

Romans 6:23 — 'The gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *I have been set free from sin. I am now a slave of righteousness.*
- *The gift of God is eternal life — not earned, freely given.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 9 *Released from the Law*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 7:1–6

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 119:41–48

Romans 7:6 — 'We serve in the new way of the Spirit, not the old way of the law.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *I have died to the law through Christ's body. I belong to Him who was raised.*
- *I serve God in the new way of the Spirit, not the old way of the letter.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 10 ■ *No Condemnation*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 8:1–11

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 139:1–14

Romans 8:1 — 'There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *There is now NO condemnation for me. The Spirit of life has set me free.*
- *My mind set on the Spirit produces life and peace.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 11 ■ *Led by the Spirit*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 8:12–25

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 40:28–31

Romans 8:16 — 'The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I am a child of God. The Spirit bears witness with my spirit.*

— *I have not received a spirit of fear but the Spirit of adoption — I cry, 'Abba!'*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 12 ■ *Nothing Can Separate Me*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Romans 8:26–39

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 62:5–12

Romans 8:38–39 — 'Nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *Nothing can separate me from the love of God in Christ Jesus.*

— *God is for me. If God is for me, who can stand against me?*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 13 *One True Gospel*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Galatians 1:6–12

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 4:20–23

Galatians 1:11 — 'The gospel I preached is not of human origin.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *The gospel I have received is not of human origin. It is the power of God.*
- *I will not trade the gospel of grace for any other system.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 14 ■ *Crucified with Christ*

NT READING

Galatians 2:11–21

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 61:1–3

Galatians 2:20 — 'I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live — but Christ in me.*

— *I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave Himself for me.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 15 *The Spirit by Faith*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Galatians 3:1–14

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 107:1–9

Galatians 3:14 — 'He redeemed us so that the blessing of Abraham might come to us.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— I received the Spirit through faith — not by works of the law.

— Christ redeemed me from the curse. The blessing of Abraham is mine.



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 16 ■ *Adopted as Sons*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Galatians 4:1–7

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 131

Galatians 4:7 — 'You are no longer a slave, but God's child; and an heir.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— I am no longer a slave but a son. God has made me an heir through Christ.

— I have received the Spirit of adoption. I can call God 'Abba, Father.'



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 17 ■ *Free Indeed*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Galatians 5:1–6

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 119:45

Galatians 5:1 — 'It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *It is for freedom that Christ has set me free. I will not return to bondage.*
- *Faith works through love. My freedom is a launching pad, not a license.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 18 ■ *Blessed in Christ*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Ephesians 1:1–14

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 16

Ephesians 1:3 — 'Blessed us with every spiritual blessing in Christ.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *I am chosen, holy, blameless, adopted, accepted, and sealed by the Holy Spirit.*
- *Every spiritual blessing in heavenly places is already mine in Christ.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 19 *Eyes of Understanding*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Ephesians 1:15–23

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 2:1–9

Ephesians 1:18 — 'The eyes of your heart may be enlightened.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *The eyes of my heart are enlightened. I know the hope of my calling.*

— *Christ is seated far above all rule and power — and I am seated with Him.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 20 ■ *God's Masterpiece*

NT READING

Ephesians 2:1–10

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 40:1–5

Ephesians 2:10 — 'We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I am God's masterpiece — created in Christ Jesus for good works.*

— *I have been saved by grace through faith. This is the gift of God.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 21 *Brought Near*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Ephesians 2:11–22

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 57:15–19

Ephesians 2:13 — 'You who were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— I have been brought near by the blood of Christ. I am no stranger to God.

— I am a member of God's household, built on the foundation of Christ.

DAY 22 ■ *Rooted in Love*

NT READING

Ephesians 3:14–21

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 36:5–9

Ephesians 3:20 — 'To him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *I am rooted and established in love. I am filled with all the fullness of God.*
- *God is able to do immeasurably more than all I ask or imagine in my life.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 23 ■ *Qualified and Delivered*

NT READING

Colossians 1:9–23

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 43:1–4

Colossians 1:13 — 'He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *God has qualified me to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.*

— *I have been delivered from darkness and brought into the kingdom of the Son.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 24 *Complete in Christ*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Colossians 2:6–15

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 23

Colossians 2:10 — 'In Christ you have been brought to fullness.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *I am complete in Christ. In Him I have been made full — I lack nothing.*
- *I have been buried with Christ and raised with Him through faith.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 25 ■ *Raised with Christ*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Colossians 3:1–4

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 23:7

Colossians 3:3 — "Your life is now hidden with Christ in God."

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I have been raised with Christ. My life is hidden with Christ in God.*

— *I set my mind on things above — my identity comes from heaven, not circumstances.*

DAY 26 ■ *Bold Access to Grace*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Hebrews 4:14–16

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 84

Hebrews 4:16 — 'Let us approach God's throne of grace with confidence.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *I can come boldly to the throne of grace. I will find mercy in my time of need.*
- *Jesus understands my weakness. He is not put off by my need.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 27 *The Better Covenant*



Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

Hebrews 9:11–15

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 85:1–7

Hebrews 9:12 — 'He entered once for all, having secured eternal redemption.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *Christ entered the holy place once for all by His own blood. My redemption is eternal.*

— *My conscience has been cleansed. I serve God out of love — not guilt.*

DAY 28 ■ *Once for All*

NT READING

Hebrews 10:1–18

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 43:25

Hebrews 10:14 — 'By one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those being sanctified.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *By one offering, Jesus has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.*
- *God says, 'I will remember their sins no more.' That includes mine.*

DAY 29 ■ *Drawing Near with Confidence*

NT READING

Hebrews 10:19–25

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 27:1–4

Hebrews 10:22 — 'Draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith.*

— *My heart is sprinkled clean. I am welcome in God's presence.*

DAY 30 ■ *The Ministry of Reconciliation* □

Phase 1 · Foundations of Grace

NT READING

2 Corinthians 5:14–21

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 103:8–14

2 Cor. 5:21 — 'God made him who had no sin to be sin for us... the righteousness of God.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I am a new creation. The old is gone — the new has come.*

— *I am the righteousness of God in Christ. This is my true identity.*

Identity & Finished Work

Days 31–60

Who you are in Christ — renewing the mind to match what heaven says about you.

- ✓ You are chosen, holy, and blameless
- ✓ Renewing your mind to truth
- ✓ Christ in you — the hope of glory
- ✓ Reigning in life through grace

DAY 31 ■ *God Is Love*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

1 John 4:7–19

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 36:5–9

1 John 4:16 — 'God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *God is love. I was loved before I ever loved Him.*

— *There is no fear in love. Perfect love — God's love — casts out my fear.*

DAY 32 ■ *Called Children of God*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

1 John 3:1–3

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 62:3–5

1 John 3:1 — 'See what great love the Father has lavished on us!'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I am called a child of God — and that is what I am.*

— *When Christ appears, I will be like Him. My transformation is guaranteed.*

DAY 33 ■ *No Condemnation — Deep Dive*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Romans 8:1–4

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 51:7–12

Romans 8:2 — 'The law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *The law of the Spirit of life has set me free from the law of sin and death.*
- *I am not under condemnation today. The verdict is in — 'not guilty.'*

DAY 34 ■ *Transformed by Beholding*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

2 Corinthians 3:4–18

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 4:18

2 Cor. 3:18 — 'We are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *As I behold the Lord's glory with unveiled face, I am being transformed.*
- *My mind is not veiled. I see God clearly — as a Father, not a judge.*

DAY 35 ■ *Renewing the Mind*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Romans 12:1–2

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 119:11–16

Romans 12:2 — 'Be transformed by the renewing of your mind.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I offer my body to God as a living sacrifice. My mind is being renewed.*

— *As I renew my mind with God's Word, I prove what His will is.*

DAY 36 ■ *Thinking Right*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Philippians 4:4–9

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 23:7

Philippians 4:8 — 'Whatever is true... think about such things.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *Whatever is true, noble, right, pure — this is what I choose to think about.*

— *I guard my thought life. What I think shapes who I become.*

DAY 37 *Content in Christ*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Philippians 4:10–13

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 23

Philippians 4:13 — 'I can do all this through him who gives me strength.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— I have learned contentment in all circumstances. Christ is my strength.

— I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 38 ■ *Abiding in the Vine*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

John 15:1–11

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 1

John 15:5 — 'Apart from me you can do nothing. I am the vine; you are the branches.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I am a branch connected to the true Vine. I am designed to bear much fruit.*

— *Jesus chose me. I did not choose Him first. I am His choice.*

DAY 39 *The Good Shepherd*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

John 10:1–18

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 100

John 10:10 — 'I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *Jesus is my Good Shepherd. He laid down His life for me willingly.*

— *I know His voice. I follow Him — not fear, not condemnation.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 40 ■ *Unity with the Father*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

John 17:20–26

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 91:1–4

John 17:23 — 'The Father loves them even as he has loved me.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *Jesus prayed for ME. He prayed that I would be one with the Father.*
- *The same love the Father has for Jesus, He has for me.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 41 ■ *Walking by the Spirit*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Galatians 5:16–25

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 11:24–25

Galatians 5:25 — 'Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *I walk by the Spirit. The fruit of the Spirit is produced in me naturally.*
- *I have crucified the flesh with its passions. I belong to Christ.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 42 ■ *Put On the New Self* □

Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Ephesians 4:17–32

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 51:10–12

Ephesians 4:24 — 'Put on the new self, created to be like God in righteousness.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I put off the old self. I am renewed in the spirit of my mind.*

— *I put on the new self — created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 43 ■ *Clothed in Christ*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Colossians 3:5–17

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 61:10

Colossians 3:12 — 'Clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *I have clothed myself with Christ — compassion, kindness, humility.*

— *Above all, I put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 44 *Boasting Only in Christ*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

1 Corinthians 1:26–31

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 37:23–24

1 Cor. 1:30 — 'Christ Jesus has become our wisdom, righteousness, sanctification.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *God chose the foolish things to shame the wise. My confidence is in God alone.*
- *Christ has become my wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, and redemption.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 45 ■ *Temple of the Holy Spirit*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

1 Corinthians 6:19–20

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 20:27

1 Cor. 6:19 — 'Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit?'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *My body is a temple of the Holy Spirit. I was bought at a price.*
- *I honor God with my body. I am His dwelling place on earth.*

DAY 46 ■ *Treasure in Clay Jars* □

Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

2 Corinthians 4:7–18

SUPPORTING READING

Isaiah 40:29–31

2 Cor. 4:17 — 'Our light and momentary troubles are achieving an eternal glory.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *I carry God's glory in this mortal body. His power shows through my weakness.*
- *I do not lose heart. My inner self is renewed day by day.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 47 ■ *More Than Conquerors*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Romans 8:28–39

SUPPORTING READING

Psalm 34:1–8

Romans 8:37 — 'We are more than conquerors through him who loved us.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

— *In all things, God works for my good. I am more than a conqueror through Christ.*

— *Nothing — nothing — can separate me from the love of God in Christ Jesus.*



OUR PRACTICAL FAITH

DAY 48 ■ *The Nature of Faith*



Phase 2 · Identity & Finished Work

NT READING

Hebrews 11:1–6

SUPPORTING READING

Proverbs 3:5–6

Hebrews 11:1 — 'Faith is confidence in what we hope for, assurance about what we do not see.'

SPEAK ALOUD — TODAY'S CONFESSIONS

- *Faith is the substance of things hoped for. I see by faith, not by sight alone.*
- *Without faith it is impossible to please God. My faith matters — and God rewards it.*
